

Houston Electric League 2022 Fishing Tournament – Rules

1. All fish must be caught by rod & reel, artificial lures or live bait may be used.
2. All fish must be caught during the event.
3. Tournament will begin at sunrise (6am) June 11th and will conclude at 2:00pm sharp at the O'Neals Grill & Bar in Baytown. **Weigh in opens @ 1pm and will close at 2:00pm, anglers who are not at the weigh in location by 2:00pm will be excluded from the prize pool.** You do not need to have your fish weighed by 2:00pm but you must be counted present at the tournament site by the tournament organizer. If you are fishing as a team, all members must be on dry land at O'Neals Grill & Bar in Baytown at the stroke of 2:00pm.
4. Sunrise is considered to be no later than 6am. You may have your boat in the water before 6am but your first line in the water may not be before.
5. Fishing boundaries are the entire Galveston Bay Complex to San Luis Pass.
6. Any person fishing out of the boundaries will be disqualified.
7. All state and federal laws apply. All Coast Guard and Texas Parks & Wildlife's regulations apply.
8. **No more than 4 anglers can combine their catch to turn in their results as a team. (meaning no more than 4 anglers on a team).**
9. 1st, 2nd & 3rd place prizes will be awarded for the heaviest stringer of (2) Speckled Trout. **You may weigh in two Trout over 25" if you combine your results as a team. 1st Place will payout \$500, 2nd Place will payout \$300, 3rd Place will payout \$100.**
10. 1st, 2nd & 3rd place prizes will be awarded for the heaviest stringer of (2) Redfish. Redfish must be within the legal slot size of 20"-28". **1st place will payout \$500, 2nd place will payout \$300, 3rd place will payout \$100.**
11. **\$1000 1st Place Grand Prize will be awarded for the best combined stringer of (2) Trout and (2) Redfish.**
12. **1st place will be awarded for the heaviest Flounder (\$150).**
13. **An angler or team may only win one 1st, 2nd or 3rd place prize in the Trout or Redfish division, not both. For example, a team weighs in the leading stringer of Redfish and the second leading stringer of Trout, this team would only win the Redfish prize pool but would still be eligible for the top prize for overall stringer.**
14. **When a tie exists, with respect to weight, then the first fish/stringer weighed in will be declared the winner, unless the Tournament Directors rule otherwise.**
15. The weigh master will have the ultimate ruling on all posted weights and determination if a fish is eligible to be included in the tournament. Catch does not need to be live but weigh master will have the authority to disqualify any catch that is determined to be landed prior to the tournament start time.
16. You may launch your boat from any location in the Galveston Bay Complex. There will not be a captains meeting the morning of the tournament.
17. **Tournament entry fee must be paid before the tournament begins.**
18. You do not have to be a member of the Houston Electric League to participate.
19. In the event of inclement weather, the tournament will be postponed until the next available weekend.

Kayak and wade fishing is encouraged. Boats may be launched from O'Neals Grill & Bar in Baytown the morning of the tournament.
